WORLD BOOK DAY



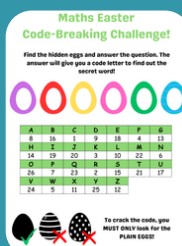
A massive thank you to everyone for making such an effort with this year's World Book Day costumes. The day was fun-filled and showed just how much reading is enjoyed at Willow Park.
